This funding will be used to

- Make progress in reading for all students as measured by at least a 1.0 effect size in Pat R and Pat M results from October 2016 to October 2017
- Demonstrated sustained improvement in reading and maths by all students as monitored by short term data cycles throughout 2017 (Semester 2 only for Maths), achieving at least 80% of all student goals
- 100% of students in 2017 above National Minimum Standards
- Mean Scale Score data to be at or above ICSEA decile of 4
- 2017 MSS and U2B NAPLAN Reading results show a relative improvement at or above National achievement in reading and writing

Our initiatives include

- Continue to embed and refine our professional learning community where teachers collect and interpret data of student need, share and evaluate strategies and their impact. Participate in professional learning and work collaboratively, including a planned Response to Intervention (WIN time) to ensure students learn at high levels.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Implement a whole school approach to the teaching of reading, writing and maths, aligned to the Australian Curriculum, Daily 5, CAFÉ and Daily 3, through building collaborative educator capacity
