Springwood Central State School will receive

This funding will be used to

- Make progress in reading for all students as measured by at least a 0.4 effect size in PAT R results from February to October 2015, and further 0.6 by October 2016
- Demonstrate sustained improvement in reading by all students as monitored by short term data cycles throughout 2015
- Enable in 2015, 100% of Year 5 students, and 97% of year 3 students at or above the NAPLAN National Minimum Standard in Reading and 100% of students in 2016 and Mean Scale Score data to be at or above our ICSEA decile of 4
- Enable in 2016, MSS and U2B NAPLAN Reading results show a relative improvement at or above National achievement

Our strategy will be to

- Establish a professional learning community where teachers collect and interpret data of student need, share and evaluate strategies and their impact, participate in professional learning and work collaboratively to ensure all students learn at high levels

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Developing and implementing a whole school approach to the teaching of reading, aligned to the Australian Curriculum, SER Reading Documents, Daily Five and CAFÉ

 - Support Staff \$40,000
 - Resources \$20,000
